## Libraries Closed

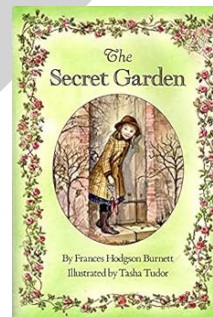
All branches of the Spartanburg County Public Libraries will be closed on Sunday, April 20 for Easter.

*Into the Bright Open: a Secret Garden Remix* by Cherie Dimaline

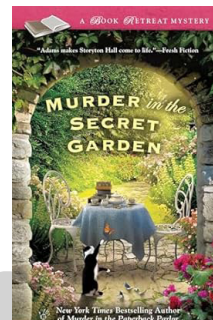
