Chautauqua: Pablo Picasso

Though born in the 19th century, Pablo Picasso was for more than 60 years of the 20th century literally the center of the Art universe. Even today in the 21st century, Picasso's influence is still pronounced. Considered his most formative years, his time in Paris transformed the 19-year-old prodigy Pablo Ruiz into the infamous Picasso. In 1907 his cubist masterpiece Les Femmes d'Alger so shattered all conventions that even his Modernist friends feared he was "losing his sanity." By 1910 Picasso had literally changed the way humanity looked at the world and it would never be the same. Registration is required for this program.
