Chautauqua: Banastre Tarleton

A young adult with a penchant for theater, gambling, horse races and tavern life, Banastre Tarleton exhausts his inheritance and purchases an officer's commission into the British Army. While in America, he distinguishes himself among his superiors, quickly rising to the rank of Lieutenant-Colonel. After being given command of the British Legion, he becomes a major player in both the northern and southern campaigns of the American Revolution. A capable cavalry commander and strategic leader, Tarleton was involved in several battles throughout the backcountry of South Carolina, becoming infamous for his reported cruelty at the Waxhaws. "Tarleton's quarter" becomes the battle cry of the patriot forces at the Battle of Cowpens.

Join us on January 16, the eve of the anniversary of the Battle of Cowpens, at 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. as we hear about history from Tarleton's point of view. ASL interpretation will be provided at the 3:00 p.m. show. Registration is required for this program.
