May is Mental Health Awareness Month

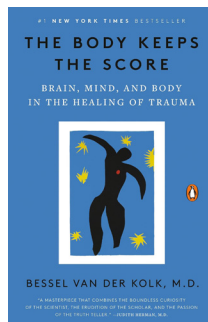

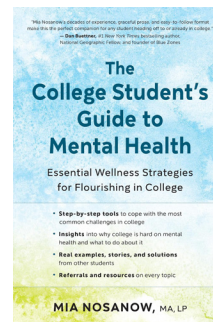
NAMI is the National Alliance on Mental Illness. They are the nation's largest grassroots mental health organization.

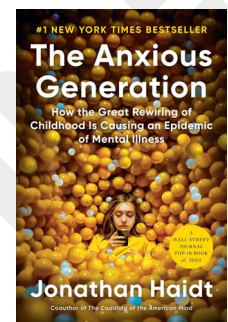

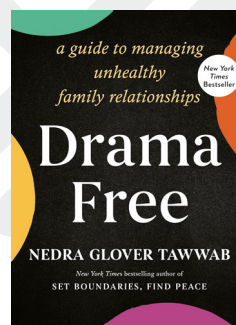

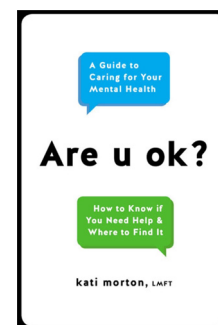
