Libraries Closed

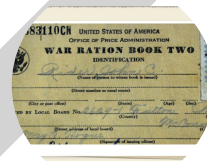

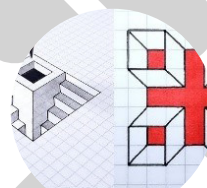

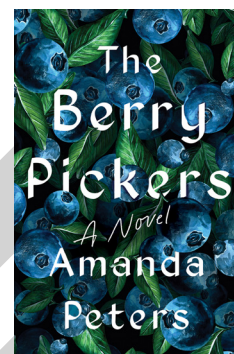
