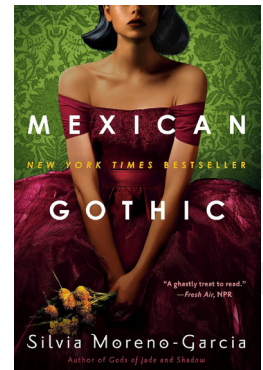
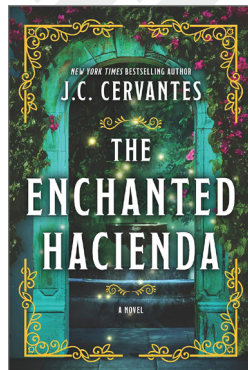
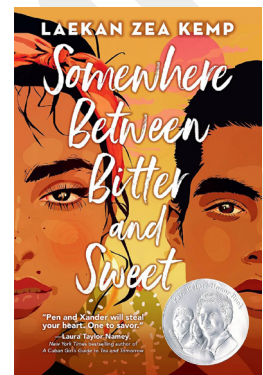
Libraries Closed
