Is it free? Yes! All our shows are free. To reserve your seat, please preregister at spartanburglibraries.org/events. Please be aware that we have two types of events: Planetarium shows in the theater and hands-on activities in the classroom. Classroom activities are limited to 25 seats.

How do I register for a show? Registrations can be made at spartanburglibraries.org/events. You can register up to 10 people on one registration for Planetarium shows and up to 3 people for classroom programs.

Can kids come too? The Planetarium is open to all ages. Most of the content of our educational films are designed with elementary and older viewers in mind, but all ages are welcome to attend. Our shows are based on current scientific research and are designed to be educational and entertaining.
